

ADDENDUM

In keeping with the goals established, a qualifying meet for AMERAUCANA bantams was held at the Ohio National Show in Columbus in Nov. of 1983, and the AMERAUCANA bantam was accepted by the American Poultry Association at their Semi-Annual Meet in Columbia, S.C. on April 6, 1984.

There was considerable support for fostering the large fowl AMERAUCANA and consequently, they were accepted by the APA in Milwaukee, in October of that same year.

Support for large fowl AMERAUCANAS from within the Ameraucana Bantam Club led to a majority vote to accept the large fowl and therefore brought about a required change in name to reflect their admission.

In 1986 the name was changed to the AMERAUCANA BREEDERS CLUB.

Having achieved every major goal of the 1980's the AMERAUCANA BREEDERS CLUB continues to serve the membership and looks forward to continued progress in the new decade.
