### REFLECTIONS

First we called them Araucanas. In the late 70's the APA made that the official name for the tufted/rumpless blue egg laying chickens and those breeding the muffed/tailed birds started calling them "American Araucanas" until it was shortened to Ameraucanas. Some will claim that Ameraucanas were bred from Araucanas, but that depends on what you mean by "Araucana". Remember the meaning of the term Araucana changed to represent a Standard breed in 1976. Before that it was fair game to use the name to mean what we now call Ameraucanas. The British and Australian Standards for their Araucanas are closer to our Ameraucanas than Araucanas.

This club owes everything to Mike Gilbert, Don Cable and the other people that worked to get it started a quarter century ago. Mike along with Jerry Segler, Bernard Kellogg and Ron Klemmedson were charter members that are still active. Wayne Meredith, Jeanette Frank and myself joined sometime during those early years, since we are listed among the 2 dozen members in the original club Handbook published in 1982. We are very blessed to have many dedicated members that have stuck with it for decades and so many newer members that have that same dedication. We seem to have a common love for Ameraucanas regardless of our gender, occupation and age.

We've come a long way baby to get to where we are now, but the battles aren't over. Still we come across the prejudices of many "old timers" that think that Ameraucanas are second class chickens or even mutts. Yes, some of those closed minded individuals are prominent breeders of other breeds, show promoters and judges, that can affect how others view Ameraucanas. We have done a good job, but need to not only continue to educate about Ameraucanas, but also be the first to speak up when mutt chickens are shown as Ameraucanas.

When I got into the club bantam wheaten, blue wheaten and white (and maybe black & blue) Ameraucanas were the only varieties that were developed to the point that they were showable. Even today there is still a lot of work to do on the bantam silvers. Since we started out as the Ameraucana Bantam Club it took a little more time for the Large Fowl (LF) to get bred to the new Standards. Some color varieties, of both bantam and LF, were accepted into the Standards before being developed. This is one reason that some varieties are very rare and precious to the breeders that are working to develop them to the point where they breed true. Ameraucanas are a relatively new breed, but they are just chickens like any old established breed that have been bred to look like what a Standard says they should look like.

My wife, Kathy, and I don't attend many poultry shows. We do try to make it to one show each year...the ABC National meet. In the old days the club didn't always have a National meet every year. These are the best opportunities to meet and fellowship with other members, buy & sell birds and find out what winning Ameraucanas really look like. I have met so many people over the past 20 plus years at our National meets, that I had only read about before. I always take a camera along to get pictures of the winning birds, so I know what to breed for. Whether or not you take birds to exhibit, please consider coming to our ABC National this October in Ohio.

It has been and continues to be an honor to be a part of the best poultry club, promoting the best poultry, for the past 25 years...The Ameraucana Breeders Club!

From The Hills Of Western Wisconsin

Because the Lucasville show management likes to encourage the entry of trios, the A.B.C. will offer special award plaques for best trios at this year's national meet. The listing of awards is printed elsewhere in this newsletter. Some A.B.C. members who plan to show at our Silver Anniversary National may not be familiar with how trio entries are judged, so here are a few basics.

A trio consists of three birds of the same variety and age classification - two females and a male. Designate "Old Trio" on the entry form if it is a cock and two hens, "Young Trio" if it is a cockerel and two pullets. A cock can not be shown in the same trio with pullets, nor can a cockerel be shown with hens.

In choosing the birds that make up a trio entry the exhibitor should remember that the two females should match as closely as possible, and the male counts for half the trio, not a third as might be expected. It is entirely possible for individual birds within a trio to win BV (Best of Variety), RV (Reserve of Variety), BB (Best of Breed), or RB (Reserve of Breed). In fact Rande Buske's white bantam trio pullet took best Ameraucana overall at our 2002 national meet in Columbus, Ohio.

A trio can be entered by itself, or it can make up part of a display. We also offer awards for best displays. A display consists of a cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, and an old or young trio for a total of seven birds in the same variety. More than one cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, or trio may be entered, but only the seven birds garnering the most points are counted toward best display. The more birds shown within a class for a given variety, the more points are earned by those that place all the way down to fifth. The best display winner is computed strictly on a mathematical basis once the placings for each class within each variety are made. By class, we mean cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, young trio, or old trio.

Our Ameraucana judge this year will be Jeannette Frank of Great Falls, Montana. Jeannette faithfully served the A.B.C. as secretary-treasurer for quite a number of years. She is a licensed American Poultry Association judge and will be able to tell us how our birds would stack up against those being raised in the northwestern United States. I know she has a good eye for detail, so make sure entries are prepared to show to their best advantage. Beaks and possibly toenails should be neatly trimmed, all feathers unbroken and immaculate. Check for those miniscule feather stubs between the toes; I had a nice bird D.Q.'ed last year because I didn't bother to check. Combs look much brighter and healthier if dead scales are removed with a medium soft toothbrush just prior to the show. And of course the birds need to be tame in order to show their type. A wild bird almost never wins in good competition.

To commemorate the 25th Anniversary of the Ameraucana Breeders Club (1978 - 2003) Northeastern Director Neil Townsend has lined up a nice array of plaques with silver engraved plates. All of us should be trying to win at least one of these, as they will certainly be a special remembrance. Mary and I are looking forward to seeing you there.
