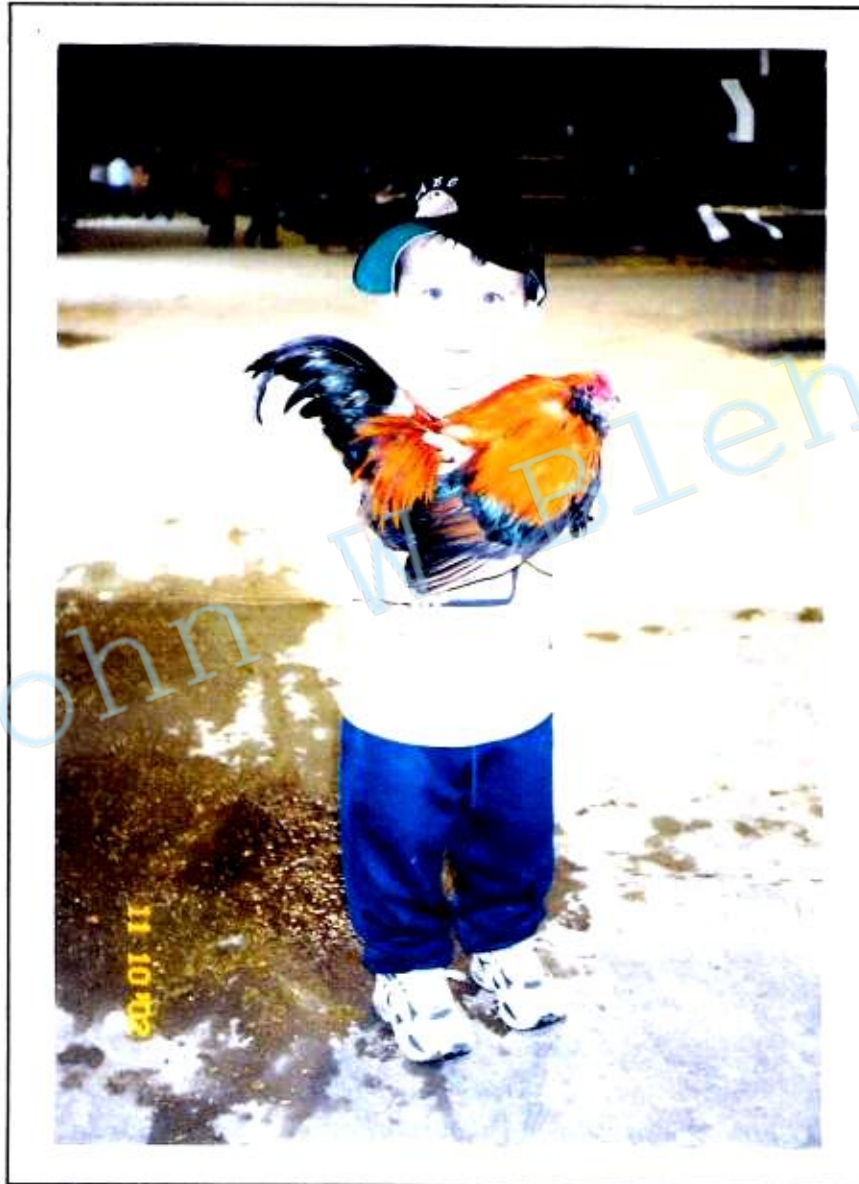

FROM THE HILLS OF WESTERN WISCONSIN

Mike Gilbert, February 2003

Your new board of directors has been busy working behind the scenes since January 1st to improve the club. I know Barbara has been putting in many hours to implement the changes, and I have heard from all the current district directors as well. The directors have voted on a number of issues, most of them discussed at the annual meeting at Columbus last November. Take the time to correspond with your district director, and offer him or her a word of encouragement. Thanks.

First of all, annual dues have been raised, effective April 1st, 2003, to \$10 per year for individuals, \$15 for family memberships, and \$8 for juniors (under age 18). This puts us in line with most breed organizations, and will help ensure good service to the membership for the immediate future. Due to personal expense and effort, the dues of the secretary-treasurer will be waived for the period of time he or she holds that office.

Next, it was affirmed by unanimous vote that we will continue to use the club logo that was produced many years ago by Rusty Hart who is currently the official American Bantam Association artist. This logo is reproduced, among other places, on the first page of the ABC Handbook (blue cover). Incidentally, Rusty also created the Ameraucana rooster depicted on the cover of the handbook. Rusty has never charged us a penny for all the work he did for us, and for that we are grateful. Thanks, old friend.

The directors also voted to adopt as our official policy for ABC show meets the policy that was published in the Winter 2002 ABC Bulletin. Please refer to that newsletter for details, and contact yours truly for further clarification or interpretation.

The fourth item approved was to purchase a club membership in the American Bantam Association at a cost of \$25 per year. For this we get, among other benefits, a free listing in the ABC Yearbook on a special "Thank You" page with contact information, a free listing in the ABA Quarterly newsletters, a free link to our website from the ABA website, and our national and district meets listed on the ABA website calendar and in the ABA quarterly newsletters. A very good value.

The directors also voted to rename the three northernmost districts to conform with the three southernmost districts. Effective immediately, the former Eastern District is the Northeastern District, the former Central District is the North Central District, and the former Western District is the Northwestern District. Please refer to the map on the website for the states that comprise each district, or ask Barbara for a map.

The Board also voted to purchase an annual advertisement in the Show Bird Journal, similar to the one we have in Poultry Press. This expenditure will be evaluated after one year to ascertain its value to the ABC. Renewal to be based on that evaluation.

The following issue that was approved is being reproduced here verbatim, so that no misunderstanding occurs within our membership of what exactly is being changed.

"The ABC shall petition the American Poultry Association and the American Bantam Association to make the following Ameraucana description changes.

1. Change description of shank color on blues, blacks, and brown-reds to the following: "Slate to black, bottoms of feet and toes white."
2. Change the plumage color description of brown-red Ameraucanas to read: "Color same as Brown-red Cochin bantams, page 290."

Note: Brown-red is recognized only for Cochin bantams, not large fowl. But Ameraucanas in both large and bantam are to be colored like the Cochin bantams."

Finally, a proposal was made to institute a point system for wins at ABC meets by ABC members for the purpose of recognizing those individuals who do well at the shows. This proposal ended in a tie vote, and since there was not a majority it did not pass. All the other

measures discussed above were passed unanimously. No doubt the point system, or some variation of it, will come up for discussion again.

At the urging of member Carl "Eli" Shepherd, it was decided to go back to issuing membership cards to paid members. Carl has a number of other good suggestions that will no doubt be considered later when time avails itself.

That's it for now. Happy hatching, and may each of you have a successful 2003.
