President's Message ~ Connie "Jean" Ribbeck



Hello everyone and welcome to the 2014 breeding season! I know some of you have already started your hatches and some are waiting for warmer weather as most of the country has experienced extreme weather conditions over the past few weeks. We were lucky and only had about two weeks of extreme cold weather that we are not used to here in the Northwest.

Spring is fast approaching and it seems as if meet requests are coming in a little slower than normal in the South Central and Western Districts. Please keep an eye on the ABC

Forum to check for updates as I have heard of a few requests that should be coming in.

This year I will again be working on projects within most of the varieties on my farm. I will be working on the third generation LF chocolates, sixth generation bantam chocolates, second generation bantam blue lacing and silver laced. I am continuing to try and improve the color in my silvers and the wheaten and blue wheaten pens. I will be crossing the buffs to black this year to try and improve laying rates and egg color. The buff outcross to wheaten seems to be too extreme to handle with the leakage in the wings and tails. There are so many projects to list, but I am excited to get started.

This is an election year. This summer we will be accepting nominations for the positions on the Board of Directors, including the President and Secretary/Treasurer positions. If you are interested in any of the positions feel free to speak up. The following is the procedure we follow:

Article VII - Election of Officers

Any paid member in good standing may send in a nomination for candidates for the various offices. All nominees must be members of the Ameraucana Breeders Club at the time of nomination. Officers shall be elected every two years by means of a mail ballot sent to each member. Such ballots shall be mailed by the Secretary/Treasurer via the club bulletin in the fall of the election year. Voting may be by mailing a marked ballot or via email within ten days after receipt directly to the Election Commissioner. When only one member accepts the nomination for any office, that person will be elected by acclamation. The election shall be completed and the new officers declared by mid-December and the new officers shall assume office on January 1st.

The Club recently published a new handbook, they are available to all new members and current members can get one by ordering one for \$6.00. We have a link on the ABC site for Club merchandise including a nifty order form John has made.

We recently lost a valued member of our Club, Patty Pickard. She was a prominent breeder of bantam Ameraucanas, the Club's points keeper, and she was very involved with our junior members. Patty and her

husband donated monetary awards to our National Meet every year for the juniors. Patty was also a well know breeder of call ducks and belonged to a couple other Clubs where she was a major supporter of youth activities. She will be missed not only by our Club, but by the exhibition community as a whole.

Greetings from the South-Central District

Show season is nearing completion with meets scheduled for South Texas State Fair in Beaumont on March 29; Missouri State Poultry Association in Sedalia, on April 19 still remaining. It's been great to have several ABC members participate in the shows this year. Hopefully they will continue to increase. We haven't shown as much this year, due to not having

much to show, due to selling so many of our day old chicks last year. Plan on keeping more this time and get back to showing more.

Our first chicks to ship this year will be sent out before this is in print. We are still accepting more chick orders but are nearing capacity. We send out just over 1,000 a year and are anticipating doing the same this year, but hatching more than in the past years.

The 35 head of open large fowl were very nice and good representation of the Ameraucana class this year. Dian Diarh judged both the open and the Jr. Ameraucanas. The Jr. show had 3 EEL this year. Christian Shank of Dallas had BB and Res. AOSB on a black hen. The RB either wasn't marked or I missed recording it. There were 11 head of Ameraucanas in the Jr. show.

The Bluebonnet Classic qualified for a special meet with 4 exhibitors. Congratulations to Aaron Hickson of Shiro on his blue hen which won best AOSB. Aaron also had RB on a black hen. Aaron showed the only bantams-lavender hens which can only win best Any Other Variety of Ameraucanas as they currently are not a recognized variety of Ameraucanas. Preston Cummings showed the only Jr. large fowl a blue hen which also won best AOSB. Jeff Maxwell judged the open show large fowl and Doug Connally judged the open bantams. Sam Brush judged the Jr. show.
